

REVIEW GUIDELINES

The vEda vaaNee e-Journal uses blind review, which means that both the reviewer and author identities are concealed from the reviewers, and vice versa, throughout the review process.

To facilitate this, authors need to ensure that their manuscripts are prepared in a way that does not give away their identity.

To assist with this process, the key items that need to be observed are as follows:

- Use the third person to refer to work the Authors have previously undertaken, e.g. replace any phrases like “as we have published before” with “... has been published before [Anonymous, 2020]” .
- Make sure figures do not contain any affiliation related identifier
- Do not eliminate essential self-references or other references but limit self-references only to papers that are relevant for those reviewing the submitted paper.
- Cite papers published by the Author in the text as follows: ‘[Anonymous, 2020]’.
- Do not include acknowledgments
- Remove any identifying information, including author names, from file names and ensure document properties are also anonymized.
