All manuscripts submitted to the *vEda vaaNee* are expected not to have been published elsewhere and not to be under review for a possible publication elsewhere. A duly signed 'Copy Right Certificate' should be submitted to the Editor along with the manuscript. Manuscripts, including notes, should not be more than 15 pages in length.
